Aspen Panels

Only two hours to create one of these gorgeous Aspen panels to hang in a window or on your wall! Start with a base of clear glass (approximately 8"x6.5"), or a sky colored wispy glass (approximately 10"x6"), and use powder, frit, stringer, and glass paints to make your vision come to life!

Learn how to make one of these beautiful sun catchers. You will learn how to grind, foil and solder using our precut glass. Students will then attach a jump ring for hanging their creation, then learn how to apply patina and polish.

Beginning Copper Foil

Learn Stained Glass in a month! This is the Tiffany style of creating stained glass. Students will complete two projects: a sampler piece, and a small panel with approximately 15-20 pieces. Twenty hours of instruction covers most basic cutting techniques, glass grinding, foiling, soldering and finishing. Tools and materials are provided for sampler piece. Students are responsible for purchase of pattern materials, glass, foil, solder, zinc framing, rings & chain for second piece (approximately \$30-\$60). Class consists of orientation session, plus additional hours to be arranged with instructor.

MOSAIC GLASS

Garden Rock Mosaics

Learn the basics of Mosaics by making a beautiful glass mosaic garden rock! Bring a simple design of your choosing on your phone or printed (a color picture helps). Students will be shown how to mix and apply grout, and sent home with a grouting kit to finish their rocks at home after their glued glass has cured.
